DON PATTON WILDLIFE TROPHY RULES

- 1. The competition shall be held annually and consist of one event only, and is open only to members of Chingford Photographic Society.
- 2. Up to six Images: digital, prints, or a combination of both may be entered by each member.
- 3. Entries must be the product of the entrant's own work and must not be composed entirely of the whole or part of another person's picture.
- 4. Whenever possible the entries will be judged by a person who is not a member of the Society.
- 5. Trophy winning images may not be entered for future Wildlife Competitions.
- 6. The trophy remains the property of Chingford Photographic Society but will be awarded to the winner of the Competition, and held for the ensuing year.
- 7. The trophy will be inscribed with the winner's name and year.
- 8. Any image substantially similar to that of a previously entered image by the same member whether winner or not may not be accepted in the same competition subject to the discretion of the Competition Secretary.
- 9. Acceptable subject matter;
 - a) The term "Wildlife" is intended to mean all forms of living creatures, falling into the categories such as :- Birds, Animals, Reptiles, Insects, Crustaceans, & Marine Life.
 - b) Flora (i.e. Plants, Flowers, & Trees etc.) are <u>not</u> admissible, except where they form part of the picture under section a).
 - c) Domestic pets or farm managed animals or birds are not admissible.
- 10. Locations of the subject(s) should be as far as possible in their natural habitat, but pictures taken in such places as Safari Parks, Parks or Reserves in a natural setting are acceptable.
