EXHIBITION GUIDELINES

We would like to have as many entries as possible from as many members as possible.

All work can be entered and will be put into the exhibition. However, the prints must be mounted on card and the largest mount acceptable will be **50cm x 40cm** **MAXIMUM**. There is no minimum size for the exhibition.

If a photograph submitted is deemed to be of a subject matter liable to cause offence, it may be subject to vetting by the Committee, and therefore may not be entered. This would be subject to discussion with the photographer. The Committee's decision will be final.

Many prints are now mounted on a single sheet of card taped on the back, which in normal circumstances does not cause a problem. However, as prints are put on the screens with sticky tabs, these can sometimes cause the tape to pull off, so if you can avoid the corners of the boards with your tape it would make life easier. This also applies to any labels (title / names etc) that you may put on the back. **Please do not use masking tape on the back of your prints. Normal 'parcel' tape is advised.**

In the past, titles have been sufficient before the exhibition. However, due to the way we want to present the prints, the actual prints must be with the Exhibition Secretary by the Monday prior to the Exhibition at the latest. If, for any reason, you cannot comply with this request, please speak to the Exhibition Secretary who may be able to find a solution. We cannot accept prints on the day.

For those who have not participated or attended our exhibition before, it is held at St Edmund's Church Hall, Chingford Mount Road, E4 (corner of Larkwood Road) on a Saturday in October. It is open to the public from 10am until 5pm. Admission is free.

Free refreshments are available all day. We like to see as many members as possible during the day.

We will need help on the Friday night prior to the Exhibition (time to be notified) to set up the screens, so please try and keep the evening free and again at the end of the exhibition to take it down.
