## PROJECTED IMAGE COMPETITION RULES

- 1. All entrants must be members of Chingford Photographic Society.
- 2. The competition will be held annually and will consist of five heats and a final.
- 3. The eight images judged to be best in each heat will go forward to the final. These entries will be held by the Competition Secretary until the final is judged and may be used for inter club battles at the discretion of the Committee.
- 4. An entry shall consist of digital images and can be up to a total of **five** images, but this number may be reduced if considered necessary by the Competition Secretary. The total number of entries will be capped to around 50 images.
- 5. Digital images must be totally the entrant's own work. The subject matter must not be the whole or part of another person's picture.
- Images should be no larger than 1920 x 1080 pixels. Images submitted in portrait format must be no more than 1080 pixels tall. Images submitted in landscape format must be no more than 1920 pixels wide.

They must be numbered and named as follows: xx\_by your name\_title.jpg

e.g. 01\_by John Smith\_Sunset.jpg 02\_by John Smith\_Flowers.jpg 03\_by John Smith\_National Gallery.jpg 04\_by John Smith\_Venice.jpg 05\_by John Smith\_Portrait of Mary.jpg

## <u>Please note</u> – the Club reserves the right to reject incorrectly sized or titled images.

- 7. All entries must be with the Competition Secretary at least **two weeks** before the competition heat. The preferred method of entering images is via the 'WeTransfer' web site, using the competition Secretary's email address. If this is difficult then a memory stick can be used or images may be emailed to the Competition Secretary or a nominated person, correctly sized and titled. If sending images from a 'Mac Book' then do not attach the individual images to an email as this will embed the images in the text at a reduced quality; instead, add the images into a compressed .ZIP file before attaching them to the email.
- 8. Whenever possible, the entries will be judged by a person who is not a member of the Society.
- 9. Any image other than the winner of the final may be entered for two heats (not necessarily the same year). The winner of the final shall not be entered for any further heats of the competition.
- 10. The winner of the final will hold the Projected Image trophy for one year.
- 11. Any image substantially similar to that of a previously entered image by the same member, whether winner or not, may not be accepted in the same competition subject to the discretion of the Competition Secretary.
- 12. All entries are accepted subject to the discretion of the Competition Secretary.
